Please accept this letter of recommendation for schoolAbility with whom I have worked in two different roles.

Currently, as Co-Executive Director of the New Mexico Coalition for Charter Schools (NMCCS) which is an advocacy and support organization for 80% of the charter schools in New Mexico, I refer schools in need of financial services to schoolAbility frequently. In the charter sector there are, unfortunately, several unqualified, site-based business officials who have unwittingly created a plethora of problems for the schools.
